

Sancti Spiritus increases its touristic potential

This traditional colonial city, Sancti Spiritus was founded in 1514, by Diego Velázquez. The colonial center is a popular stop of Marysol Travel's round trips. The splendid colonial architecture and the fact that Sancti Spiritus has less tourism than Trinidad, makes this city a secluded gem of Central Cuba. Here you can get an insight into the everyday life of Cubans, meet locals and have people-to-people interaction. The recently opened Hotel Don Florencio located on the boulevard of the city, broadens the accommodation options allowing this destination to be incorporated into the round trip itineraries.



Particular Cuba

Private restaurants (Paladar), Bed & Breakfast (Casa Particular) and private taxis, just to name a few are amongst the almost 500.000 "cuentapropistas" who offer services nowadays in Cuba for Cubans and tourists alike. This way tourists can know more about Cuba and have an insider view of this beautiful country.



Cuba, the largest island of the Caribbean, its capital is the legendary Havana. A multicolour country with its cultural and historical heritage, that makes one of the most popular destinations of the Caribbean. Rich in cultural and historical sights, beautiful beaches and untouched nature, full of architectural delights to enchant everybody, young or old. Those who visit Cuba take a time travel, as here the ancient sugar barons' richness is present together with the 1950's American mob and 1970's retro era also. Socialism creates a unique atmosphere turning this island into a compact incentive or holiday destination. Beside the sights the vibrant nightlife offers entertainment at salsa clubs and jazz bars, as perfect "add ons".



LA HABANA

Havana is a real Caribbean metropolis with more than 2.2 million inhabitants. Here everything is original, everything has style. The city's unique atmosphere, spirit and dingy beauty remind us of past ages as well as today's socialist retro. Havana provokes your creative side. It is a real treasure trove for those with an inquisitive mind. You could never get enough of Havana; this city of a thousand faces has enough variety of attractions to enable us to tailor programs and cater for any group's interests over any given time scale from 2-6 days. Old Havana and its Fortification System is listed as a UNESCO World Heritage Site.

UNESCO WORLD HERITAGE

Did you know that Cuba is exepcionally rich in UNESCO World Heritage Sites? Five out of the nine UNESCO sites are located in the Western-Central part of Cuba allowing us to complete a World Heritage Sites Tour There are three more locations indicated on World Heritage Tentative List: Cienaga de Zapata National Park, National Schools of Art and the Reef Systems in the Cuban Caribbean together with Jardines de La Reina.

SANCTI SPIRITUS

Located 80 kms East from Trinidad, Sancti Spiritus offers beautiful colonial sights. Rivalling both Trinidad and Cienfuegos for its beauty, it is almost like a secret destination. Whereas these other cities are visited en masse by tourists, Sancti Spiritus is much quieter, like Trinidad without the tourist hustle and bustle. Sancti Spiritus has preserved its charm, and maintains its heritage. The city was founded in 1514, as one of Diego Velázquez' seven original villas. Its architecture, cozy Main Square, the first brick bridge in Cuba and friendly locals make Sancti Spiritus a perfect round trip stop. It is a perfect example of a small colonial Cuban town.



VIÑALES VALLEY

Located 170 kms to the West of Havana in the province of "Pinar del Rio" lies the picturesque Valley of Viñales. On the UNESCO World Heritage List since 1999, the Valley and the village are hidden among the green slopes of the "Sierra de los Organos", running Westwards along from the Sierra Rosario. Here you can find wooded limestone humps, called "Mogotes". The landscape was formed by subterranean rivers eroding the ground and forming gigantic caves. The unique climate of Pinar del Rio province holds the secret of the world famous Cuban cigars. The leaves of the "Habanos" are grown here still using traditional techniques on family farms.




TRINIDAD

The colonial city, founded 500 years ago made its wealth from its sugar plantations. Here another side of Cuba can be discovered. The journey takes you not only in distance but in time too. The specialty of Trinidad is its colonial atmosphere preserved in its original state. Walking on the cobble-stoned streets, you feel like, you have traveled back to the 18th Century. Trinidad and the "Valle de los Ingenios" is declared as a UNESCO World Heritage Site.



CIENFUEGOS

Located 80 kms from Trinidad, Cienfuegos once was the centre of Cuban aristocracy. The city founded by French settlers has a charm different from other Cuban cities. The city's cultural life is vibrant. Benny Moré, Cuba's most famous musician was born here and a statue in his honour can be found in Prado. Alongside Prado, the city's main attractions are "Thomas Terry Theatre" – famed for its acoustics and "Palacio de Valle" – an architectural beauty of the city. Cienfuegos was recognized as a UNESCO World Heritage site in 2005.



CAMAGÜEY

Camagüey, the country's third largest city again takes you back to colonial times. Its' odd, labyrinth layout is a by-product of two centuries fighting off musket-toting pirates, like Henry Morgan. The city's main attractions, the Cathedral and Plaza de San Juan de Dios preserve faithfully the colonial era. The "City of the Tinajones" was declared as UNESCO World Heritage Site in 2008, a not to be missed stop of the Grand Tour of Cuba. With its' vibrant nightlife, the "Casa de la Trova" invites you to spend your evenings in Caribbean Fiestas.



WHAT TO DO IN HAVANA

"Anything is possible in Havana", wrote British novelist Graham Greene of Cuba's vibrant and multicolour capital, that captivates everybody.



Havana. the capital of the country with its 2.2 Million inhabitants is a real Caribbean metropolis. Bustling city, full of sights, daytime and night attractions. If you can afford only twothree days in Havana, then you should start exploring the city with the not-to-be-missed essentials: City tour of Old and Modern Havana, visit the Havana Club Rum Museum, then onto one of the Cigar Factories. Take a stroll among hundreds of tobacco rollers and learn about all the different phases of cigar making. Follow in Hemingway's footsteps you can visit his favorite haunts, the "La Floridita" and the "La Bodequita del Medio" bars; his hotel room in the Hotel Ambos Mundos. In the evening you can take in the famous Tropicana Show or the Concert of the Buena Vista Social Club. If you are a Jazz enthusiast, then vou should visit "Jazz Café" or "La Zorra v El Cuervo" jazz bars for sparkling Afro-Cuban Latin Jazz.

Havana offers more sights then can be completed within 2-3 days however! The city offers attractions and programs even for a week's stay. If you have more time, we can enrich your program with peculiarities, such as the world famous Colon Cemetery, one of the richest cemeteries in the world hiding plenty of interesting stories that the local guides of the cemetery can explain. Or we can visit Havana's "Chinatown", once the largest "Chinatowns" of Latin America. Today we find mainly restaurants and shops here, but it offers a cultural versatility mixing Chinese heritage with Cuban culture. If you would like a rest from the bustling swirl, take a trip to the Botanical Garden of Havana, where you will find a tropical oasis, housing everything from arid cacti to tropical celebrations. There are more than 600 hectares showing almost 150.000 specimens of about 4000 identified species.

If you like classic arts, the world famous Cuban Ballet directed by its founder, Alicia Alonso is not to be missed. The National Ballet of Cuba performs at the spectacular Gran Teatro de la Habana. Although Havana is the world's largest moving car museum, we can visit the "Museo de Automobil" located in La Habana Vieja (Old Havana) where we can walk among vintage Thunderbirds, Pontiacs, Rolls Royce and Ford Model T. If interested in sport, then it is undoubtingly a must to visit a baseball game at the "Estadio Latinoamericano", home of "Industriales". The MLB's most famous

Cuban players came from here, the likes of Luis Tiant, Tony Perez and Yaisel Puig. Few people know, but there is a Leonardo Da Vinci creation, the "Camara Oscura" in Havana. The clever construction is using mirrors to forward light to project the images on a canvas. It is interesting

to see the city with a bird's eye view and watching the everyday life on the top of the city. Another interesting attraction is the Scale Model of

the City of Havana, the second largest in the world after the one in New York. It shows 144 km2 of the city at a scale of 1:1000. Havana has no beaches but you do not have to renounce swimming in the sea, as just 20 kilometers from Havana are the "Plavas del Este". This is an 8 km stretch of white sandy beach, one of the few, where you can enjoy the ocean together with the locals. In case you don't want to leave town for a swim or just want to relax, then Club Habana is waiting for you. The former mansion

built in 1928, once the famous Havana Biltmore Yacht & Country Club offers private beach, swimming pool, tennis courts, bar, boutique and restaurant. It is a perfect location for events or gala dinners.

WHY CUBA?

VARADERO

The longest and most famous beach is Varadero on the North coast. With its white sand, blue sea and good hotels, there are masses of things to do and even more people to talk to. The majority of the 50 hotels are "beachfront" hotels stretching along the 20 km long white sandy beach. All hotels have their own premium beach, even the lower category hotels. Due to its prime location – only 140 kilometers from Havana and 260 kilometers from Trinidad, Varadero is an excellent destination offering many varied excursion options.

CAYO SANTA MARIA

Santa Maria Key, with its exuberant vegetation and pristine white-sand beaches is ideal for tourists who wish to enjoy the natural luxury of this exotic Key to the fullest. Some of the best hotels in Cuba are located here. The Key is joined to mainland Cuba by a 48 km causeway reaching out into the sea. Situated in the UNESCO Buenavista Biosphere Reserve at just 360 km from Havana, the Key's main appeal is its almost virginal natural environment.

CAYO LARGO

Cayo Largo del Sur is an uninhabited island paradise. Located on the Southern part of Cuba in the Caribbean Sea, the pearl of the "Canarreos island" is famous for its untouched beaches. 24 km of white sand – perfect for a relaxing stroll or a leisurely swim in the stunning turquoise waters. With only a few hotels on the island (the highest category is 4*), there is an air of perfect tranquility, as if on your own private beach a million miles away from the busy everyday life. With its perfect location in the south, the climate does not vary with the seasons. All year long beautiful weather awaits you here! A daily 45-minute flight is available from Havana or Varadero to Cayo Largo.

CAYO COCO

Cayo Coco is located in the North coast of the country. It forms part of the "Jardines del Rey" (King's Gardens) group of islands. The Island is accessible by a 27 km causeway across the sea. The island is host to a famous bird sanctuary, which includes pelicans and pink flamingoes that nest there in huge numbers. Cayo Guillermo beach is linked with Cayo Coco by road. The best beaches in the country like "Playa Pilar", one of the most stunning beaches in Cuba, are located here. Both Keys are excellent for fishing. Cayo Coco is located 535 km from Havana; ground and air transportation is available.

HOLGUIN

Holguin is the fourth largest province of Cuba. Situated at the Eastern tip of the country, this is where Columbus landed in 1492. He quoted: "most beautiful land man has ever seen". Its geographical location means it is protected from winter cold fronts. This leads to perfect climate, all year round. Its cultural and natural attractions and the development of the tourist industry over the last 15 years, makes Holguin an ideal destination. It is an ideal base to explore the Eastern part of Cuba. From here, the delights of Santiago de Cuba are readily accessible: 34 rivers, 6 waterfalls, 5 marine parks, 19 historical and cultural attractions, 22 bays and over 60 km of white sand beaches.



The Autentica Cuba Round trip introduces the "Real Cuba" that many people look for. Traveling the country from West to East, from Pinar del Rio province up to Sancti Spiritus you see the main attractions, the most significant sites and most beautiful natural treasures. The emphasis of this trip is on "authenticity", a step away from the usual touristy routes to get a taste of everyday life in the country. Our journey takes us through the natural beauty of the Cuban countryside and includes visits to UNESCO World Heritage sites which make this tour something really special. The tour is topped off by a relaxing stay on the white sandy beaches of Varadero or Cayo Santa Maria.

The first two days of our rich program are spent in Havana. From here we discover the Western part of the country "authentic Cuban style" (at a leisurely pace)! The first day is spent discovering the legend that is Havana. We visit the places of interests of Modern Havana, The Revolution Square with the José Marti Memorial and then we go for a walking tour in the Old city – a UNESCO World Heritage site since 1982. After passing the Capitolio, Plaza de Armas and Cathedral Square, we step into the famous footsteps of Ernest Hemmingway, visiting the Hotel Ambos Mundos to get a taste of his favorite cocktails, the Mojito and the Daiguiri. Then we learn about the making of rum in the Havana Club Rum Museum. In the evening we can visit the world famous Tropicana Show or take in the Concert of the Buena Vista Social Club. On the 2nd day we visit the country's green corner, the province of Pinar del Rio. Here we can learn how tobacco is produced. We visit a local tobacco farm and peek into a tobacco barn where we will find out the secret of the exquisite Cuban tobacco. Then we move on to "Los Jazmines Mirador" an awesome place to view the splendor of the amazing Viñales Valley and the famous "Mogotes", a World Heritage Site since 1999. Then we leave our base in Havana behind



Mountains where visiting an authentic Cuban ranch we can observe the everyday life in the countryside. Finally we will relax on the white sandy beaches of Varadero or Cayo Santa Maria, where all inclusive hotels await us with their comfort and tranquility.



CUBA BY NATURE ROUNDTRIP

The multicoloured culture of Cuba, its rich historical past with its architectural beauty and exceptional natural assets attract many tourists. It is an enchanting country with lots of unique attributes, each waiting to be discovered by you. Untouched natural resources are abundant. Cuba is also host to several UNESCO World Heritage Sites. Its natural beauty - mountains, valleys, rivers and beaches enchanted Christopher Columbus when he discovered the island in 1492. He wrote in his diary: "It is the most beautiful land I have ever seen". The Cuba By Nature Tour offers a unique program, that includes special places, such as the Santo Tomas Cave, whose access is limited by the local authorities for only a few lucky tourists. It is an active tour, where we discover the country by its natural beauty, and also learning of its culture and history at the same time.





The following two days of our tour we will dedicate to Pinar del Rio province. We go on a panoramic sightseeing trip in the "city of columns", and visit Soroa, where we enter the country's largest orchid farm, also called the "Rainbow of Cuba". We view the beautiful Viñales Valley and the unique "Mogotes" from the "Mirador Los Jazmines". The unique climate of this land holds the secret of the excellent Cuban tobacco. We visit the verdure tobacco fields; we learn the procedures involved in tobacco production and the rolling of cigars. Our accommodation is an authentic Cuban ranch. We tour the former Spanish estate spread over 1000 hectares, visit the plantations and the stables where Cuban horses were

bred and kept. We continue the adventure on horseback or those who don't ride, can go bird watching or boat on the lake nearby. Our program continues by visiting the largest cave system in Latin America, the "Santo Tomas Cave". We explore the cave's 8 levels and 45 kilometres with a specialist local quide.

During our next days' program we encounter the flora and fauna of Cuba in the "Cienaga Zapata" National Park where we can see crocodiles in their natural habitat. We visit a crocodile breeding farm and learn of the endemic species of birds. We will speedboat in a natural lagoon, observing the flora and fauna. Later we will relax in a hotel on the beach of the Caribbean Sea.

Our diverse tour's next days feature cultural and historic trips again, enriched with additional UNESCO site visits, as we take in Cienfuegos and Trinidad. We walk the Malecon, marvel at the Palacio del Valle, stroll down the Prado to greet "Benny More" and admire the main square of the city. Later we travel back in time to visit Trinidad, a preserved 18th century city. We unravel the colonial beauty of the city, try a local drink - the "Canchanchara" and visit the Romantic Museum.

By visiting the Sugar Mills Valley we enter the "Iznaga" family estate. Once an opulent family, we will see the memories of colonial Cuba, evidence of the late Sugar Barons' richness and the everyday life of the colonial era. In Trinidad the evenings are always "hot". On the main square is the "Fiesta de Salsa", where sitting on the "slave stairs" we can watch the moves of local dancers whilst listening to live music

After the cultural sites we go on a real adventure tour to the Escambray Mountains. This will be our tour's most amusing part: an unforgettable trip, we will travel to the Mountains on the back of a Russian "Zil" truck to



"Topes de Collantes". This is a mountain community, where we start a jungle tour in the Guanayara Natural Park discovering the local flora and fauna. We shall see the 62 metre high "El Rocio" waterfall and then we will swim in the "El Venado" natural lagoon. Our mountain adventure will be crowned on the "Casa de Gallega" ranch with typical Cuban food and a Caribbean siesta. Our tour ends on the white sandy beaches of either Varadero or Cayo Santa Maria, where we can relax in one of the many excellent all-inclusive beach resorts.

The Cuba by Nature program is led by skilled local specialized tour guide. We include in each destination an additional specialist of the area with the group to get the deepest knowledge possible. These professionals know their area in details, specialize in their field of expertise and share their knowledge with the group. The difficulty of the tours is easy to moderate: can be executed by all persons of average health, accessible to all, who are doing some movement regularly, and who are used to walk. Programs include 3-4 hours walk per day, without much carrying. We propose this tour for those looking for active holidays, who like the proximity of nature. It is an ideal program for groups and team building.

GRAND TOUR CUBA ROUNDTRIP

The "Grand Tour Cuba" program travels Cuba completely, offering a full knowledge of this multicoloured country and all its peculiarities. The tour goes from the Eastern tip of the country in Santiago de Cuba including Baracoa, to its most Westerly tip in Pinar del Rio – covering the length of the entire island. The program is especially rich and includes visits to all sites whilst maintaining a relaxed Caribbean style pace.

From first base Havana, we take a domestic flight to Santiago de Cuba. The tour can be expanded with all inclusive vacation on the beach. This is an excellent combination of touring; getting a feel for the "real" Cuba as well as relaxing on the beach. We suggest this program for those who are interested in the culture and history of the country and want to participate in a complete, rich program.

We start the round trip by discovering Havana. We visit the modern part of Havana, and through a walking tour we visit the sights of Habana Vieja that was declared as a UNESCO World Heritage Site in 1982. We enter to Havana Club Rum Museum and in the footsteps of Hemingway we learn about his life in Cuba and the favourite cocktails of the famous writer. Then with the evening flight, we fly to the Eastern tip of the country to Santiago de Cuba. We will start our trek back to Havana from here with a fun-filled two-week tour. Santiago de Cuba is the second capital of Cuba. We can visit the house of Diego Velazquez, the conqueror of Latin America, which is situated in "Parque Cespedes", the oldest city centre square of the country. We can stroll along the "Dolores" and "Marte" squares, explore the "Castillo de Morro", which had an important role in the war of independence, and we can visit the tomb of José Marti. We will go on a boat excursion to Cayo Granma to visit local fishermen and we will visit the most famous pilgrimage destination in

Cuba – "El Cobre". The statue of the "Virgin Mary" or "Caridad del Cobre" as she is known in Cuba is said to have ethereal powers.

We take a look from "La Gran Piedra" (Big Stone) observatory and take a panoramic tour of

Guantanamo before continuing our trip to the first recognised settlement of the country - Baracoa.



This city is a special gem of Cuba with its almost untouched natural beauty and historical heritage.

Here we can have a taste of the "Real" Cuba. We visit the Humboldt National Park, a UNESCO World Heritage Site since 2001, and a real specialty of the tour. The trip enters to "Finca Biran", where the Castro brothers were born and raised. We visit Holguin, the second largest city of Cuba, the "city of parks", and then stop at Camagüey, a UNESCO city with its winding streets once built to fight against the pirates. We visit the main sites, the Cathedral, the birthplace of Cuba's national poet, Nicolas Guillen and many more. Then we continue our trip to Sancti Spiritus, a small town founded in 1514, where the country's oldest brick built bridge can be found. In the evening we can go to

the "Casa de la Trova" and watch or learn to dance salsa there. (As at every other stop on the trip!) By the end of the tour you could be an accomplished almost professional salsa dancer! All our quides are also excellent dancers.

Arriving to the Escambray Mountains in the centre of the country, our round trip gets more intense as there are more UNESCO sites as well as natural, cultural and historical sites one after the other on the way. At the Escambray we visit a real

Cuban ranch offering a "Cuban Day" where we can experience the everyday life in the rural countryside. Then we visit the World Heritage Site Sugar Mills Valley, the former estate of the Iznaga family,

where we can have an excellent panorama from the top of the slave tower. Entering Trinidad we travel back in time to the 18th Century, to the colonial era visiting the main square of the city, the Romantic Museum, the cobble stoned streets in this UNESCO city. Our next stop is Cienfuegos. Founded by French settlers and also part of the UNESCO World Heritage Sites, here we encounter the amazing architecture of the "Palacio de Valle" palace. Strolling along Prado we can feel the pace of the city that is different from the other Cuban cities. Our round trip cannot miss the Cienaga de Zapata National Park. This is one of the most important Natural Reserves housing many endemic

flora and fauna. We will visit a
Crocodile breeding farm, go
speed boating on the Laguna
de Tresoro, visit a reconstructed
aboriginal village, and see
crocodiles and other wildlife in
their natural habitat in the swamp.
To complete our round trip we go
on a tour to the Western corner
of Cuba, to Pinar del Rio province,
where the famous Cuban tobacco
is produced. We visit a tobacco

plantation, enter a tobacco barn and get to know the process of cigar making while visiting an original tobacco producing family's farm.

Then we move on to the UNESCO World Heritage Site of Viñales Valley,

take a boat into the "Cueva del Indio" and visit the "Mural de la Prehistoria" huge wall painting, which was made using a unique technique. At the end of our cross country trip we return to Havana, allowing us to finish off the complete tour with a relaxing beach vacation on the beautiful white sandy beaches of Varadero, Cayo Largo, Cayo Coco or Cayo Santa Maria, all easily reachable from Havana.






